Academic Analytics	Provides data on primary areas of scholarly achievement represented in research-intensive programs. Campus leaders can use data and tools to analyze programs, departments and schools in order to make strategic decisions, benchmark scholarly research activity and support program review. Activity Insight (Digital Measures)	Activity Insight will replace the “FAR” (Faculty Annual Report) in Fall 2016. Career Opportunities and Outcomes (IUPUI Talent and First Destination Survey)	The IUPUI Talent Job Board (Symplicity) is the central portal through which employers register and post part-time, internship, and full-time opportunities that can be viewed by almost all IUPUI students. Reports are available on employer interest by school and industry. The First Destination Survey annually reaches at least 40% of that year’s graduates to ascertain their post-graduation employment and education plans. EAB (Educational Advisory Board) Student Success Dashboard	EAB Student Success Collaborative Campus (EAB SSC Campus) is a student success management platform for IUPUI academic advisors, student mentors, career services professionals, and other student success educators and administrators. The platform offers users the ability to conduct comprehensive searches for students using robust filtering criteria, to lead outreach and appointment campaigns, to manage front desk and workshop check-ins, and to gain insights into analytics that predict course completion and graduation.
